

# How-To Guide: Creating Printable Tasting Room Materials (for Non-Designers)

No graphic design experience? No problem. Here's how to build polished materials using easy tools.

#### Step 1: Choose Your Design Tool

Google Docs	Fast and simple layouts, printable	docs.google.com
Adobe Express	More customizability, still beginner-friendly	www.adobe.com/express

#### Step 2: Plan Your Layout

- Decide the material type (e.g., menu, flyer, sign)
- Sketch a quick layout idea
- Gather: logos, wine descriptions, contact info, brand colors

## Step 3: Use a Template

- Go to Canva and search templates ("Wine Tasting Menu," "Event Flyer")
- Customize with your content, images, and brand colors

# **Step 4: Make It Print-Ready**

- Set size: US Letter (8.5x11) or Postcard (5x7)
- Use clean fonts: Lato, Raleway, Garamond
- Leave safe margins; text size 12pt+
- Download: PDF Print format

## **Step 5: Print or Display**

- Print on cardstock for quality
- Add QR codes for digital signups or menus
- Save all designs in a central folder (Google Drive or Dropbox)

#### **Bonus Tips**

- Reuse seasonal templates
- Review content quarterly
- Keep branding consistent across all materials
